Passenger car and light truck tires ~ with or without rims

The Tire Disposal Center is open for residents of Canton who need to dispose of passenger car and light truck tires. There is a limit of 12 tires per year per household. Tires can be dropped off at the Disposal Center FREE with ID. Check in at office upon arrival. (Please note that tires will NOT be picked up by Sanitation.)

Under Ohio EPA scrap tire regulations in effect as of September 1, 1996, persons hauling more than ten (10) scrap tires in a load must be registered with the Ohio EPA as a scrap tire transporter. For more information about registration or the Scrap Tire Program, please call the Ohio EPA scrap tire unit at (614) 644-2621. Transporting ten (10) scrap tires or less per load requires no registration.

Persons having to dispose of larger quantities of scrap tires may call the following companies, which are registered as scrap tire transporters, to arrange for removal of the tires and proper disposal:
