

DO:

- ◆ Use trash containers no larger than 32 gallons.
- ◆ Use trash containers with handles and lids that are not hinged or attached.
- ◆ Bags may be used without containers for trash pick-up (if animals get into the bags, it is the resident's responsibility to clean up).
- ◆ Trash must be stored in between pick-ups / collections in cans with tight-fitting lids.
- ◆ Make sure your trash is curbside by 6:00 AM on your scheduled pick-up day. Sanitation employees start work at 6:00 AM.
- ◆ Yard waste such as grass clippings, leaves and twigs must be separately bagged and placed at the curb.
- ◆ Bags should not exceed 32 gallons for grass and 45 gallons for leaves.
- ◆ Branches and brush should be bundled and tied in manageable bundles (maximum 6 feet in length) and placed at the curb.
- ◆ Christmas trees should be placed at the curb and will be collected on the customer's regular pick-up day.
- ◆ Carpeting must be cut down to manageable size (maximum 6 ft length), tied securely and placed at the curb.
- ◆ Appliances and water heaters will be picked up at no additional cost. Just place your appliance at the curb or alley side on your normal pick-up day. The Sanitation crew will call the address in to the office and the appliance will be picked up by a separate truck (under normal circumstances within 2 working days).
- ◆ Two (2) large items per week (i.e. furniture) may be placed at curb side on regular collection day at no additional charge.
- ◆ Dumpsters may be rented for special household clean-out.

DON'T:

- ◆ Construction Material: The Sanitation Department does not collect or haul construction materials with its normal pick-up. They will haul such materials separately for an additional fee. Call 330-489-3020.
- ◆ **Please note:** The following items will **not** be picked up by the Sanitation Department under any circumstances, including special pick-ups: asphalt, concrete, bricks, roofing material, tree stumps, logs, railroad ties, automobile parts, ashes, rock, dirt, paint or liquids of any type.
- ◆ Animal waste (feces) will not be picked up unless placed in a small, sturdy double plastic bag or wrapped in newspaper and placed in a small, sturdy plastic bag. Cat litter can be placed in coffee cans, sturdy plastic bags or grocery bags that are placed inside plastic bags. These "double bagged" packages of animal waste can then be placed in your regular, larger trash bag. **Sanitation will not collect animal waste if it is not properly packaged or if the amount is excessive.** Persons violating this policy will be reported to the Canton City Health Department. Further inquiry about animal waste can be made by contacting the Canton Health Department at 330-489-3327.
- ◆ Tires will **NOT** be picked up by Sanitation but can be dropped off at the Schroyer Recycling-Drop-off Facility (tires only — no rims) located at 742 Schroyer Ave. SW, between Sixth and Ninth Streets SW; (330) 430-7869. Hours are Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.
- ◆ Vacant Structures: The Sanitation Department does not maintain regular pick-up at vacant homes. After the home is vacated, a final pick-up will be made. Another pick-up will be made prior to the occupation of the property. The Sanitation Department has found that regular pick-up at vacant properties results in outsiders fraudulently depositing trash in front of the structure. If the period between the final clean-out and pre-move-in pick-up is greater than two (2) months, the property owner may apply for a waiver of their sanitation charge for that period.
